HOUSE BILL 1436

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; requiring the completion of certain interchange; requiring specifications; prohibiting toll charge for certain section of turnpike; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1912 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Transportation Authority shall complete an interchange located on the Chickasaw Turnpike at U.S. 177 at Sulphur no later than July 1, 2007. The interchange construction specifications shall be in accordance with the standards and specifications of the Department of Transportation. After the completion of the interchange, the section of the Chickasaw Turnpike that extends north from State Highway 7 to State Highway 177 for four (4) miles shall not charge a toll for use of that section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
