HOUSE BILL 1481

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public property and entities; prohibiting use of elected or previously elected official's name in certain circumstances for certain period of time; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 50 of Title 61, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No public facility, structure, room, road, bridge, lake, park, campus, program, event, act, or entity of any kind shall be named for any person who has been elected to public office while that person is in office, or for ten (10) years after the person has left public employment in the State of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
