HOUSE BILL 1616

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001, Section 7107, which relates to the Oklahoma Child Abuse Reporting and Prevention Act; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2001, Section 7107, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7107. A. Except as otherwise provided by the Oklahoma Child Abuse Reporting and Prevention Act, the reports required by Section 7103 of this title or any other information acquired pursuant to the Oklahoma Child Abuse Reporting and Prevention Act shall be confidential and may be disclosed only as provided in Section 7111 of this title and the Oklahoma Children's Code.

B. Except as otherwise provided by the Oklahoma Child Abuse Reporting and Prevention Act, any violation of the confidentiality requirements of the Oklahoma Child Abuse Reporting and Prevention Act shall, upon conviction, be a misdemeanor punishable by up to six (6) months in jail, by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by both ~~such~~ fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
