HOUSE BILL 1631

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to children; requiring the State Registrar to provide certificate of birth to certain persons; providing conditions upon submitting certificate of birth; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7505-6.6A of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other section of law, beginning upon the effective date of this act, the State Registrar shall provide all adopted persons upon request, regardless of when the adoption was finalized, with an uncertified copy of the original certificate of birth, if the following conditions are met:

1. The adopted person has submitted satisfactory proof of identity; and
2. The State Registrar has submitted an affidavit in which the adopted person states under oath that the adopted person does not have a biological sibling under the age of eighteen (18) who is currently in an adoptive family and whose location is known to be the adopted person.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
