HOUSE BILL 1640

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 6-202, which relates to suspending privileges of nonresidents and reporting convictions; modifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 6-202, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-202. A. The privilege of driving a motor vehicle on the highways of this state given to a nonresident hereunder shall be subject to suspension or revocation by the Department in like manner and for like cause as any Oklahoma ~~driver's~~ driver license issued hereunder may be suspended or revoked. Any person who does not possess a valid ~~driver's~~ driver license in this state or any foreign state may have his or her privilege to operate a motor vehicle in this state suspended or revoked in like manner and for like cause as a ~~driver's~~ driver license issued hereunder may be suspended or revoked.

Persons whose driving privileges have been suspended because of failure to furnish proof of insurance shall be required to furnish proof of financial responsibility as required by the provisions of the Financial Responsibility Act.

B. The Department of Public Safety is further authorized, upon receiving a record of the conviction in this state of a nonresident driver of a motor vehicle of any offense under the motor vehicle laws of this state, to forward a certified copy of ~~such~~ the record

to the motor vehicle administrator in the state wherein the person so convicted is a resident.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
