HOUSE BILL 1698

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to court clerks; prohibiting dissemination of certain information on court-controlled website; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 39 of Title 12, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning November 1, 2005, no court clerk shall post on a court-controlled website any document that contains the following information:

1. The name of a crime victim;
2. The address of a crime victim;
3. The telephone number of a crime victim;
4. A social security number of a crime victim;
5. A date of birth of a crime victim; and
6. The place of employment of a crime victim.

B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit access to any original document as provided by law.

C. For purposes of this section, "crime victim" means any person against whom a crime was committed, except homicide, in which case the victim may be a surviving family member including a stepbrother, stepsister or stepparent, or the estate when there are no surviving family members other than the defendant, and who, as a

direct result of the crime, suffers injury, loss of earnings, out-of-pocket expenses, or loss or damage to property.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
