HOUSE BILL 1701

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to mental health; directing certain expenditures at the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services shall fund domestic violence and sexual assault programs at a level equal to fifteen percent (15%) of the annual appropriation to the Department.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
