HOUSE BILL 1749

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2001, Section 4-113, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 545, O.S.L. 2004 (26 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 4-113), which relates to voter identification cards; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 4-113, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 545, O.S.L. 2004 (26 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 4-113), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-113. A. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall devise a voter identification card which shall be issued to every person who becomes a registered voter in Oklahoma. ~~Said~~ The voter identification card shall contain such information as is necessary to determine a registered voter's eligibility.

B. When a person registers to vote or changes ~~his or her~~ registration in any manner to require a new voter identification card, the county election board secretary in the county of the voter's residence shall transmit the new voter identification card as acknowledgment of the transaction which may be the notice required in Section 4-103.1 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
