HOUSE BILL 1757

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tourism and recreation; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 1847.4, which relates to accounts, contracts, documents, and records of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission; clarifying statutory language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 1847.4, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1847.4 The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission shall cause to be kept complete and accurate accounts of all transactions and affairs of the Commission, conforming to approved methods of bookkeeping. ~~Such~~ The accounts and ~~the~~ contracts, documents and records of the Commission shall be kept at its principal office and shall be open to public inspection at all reasonable times.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
