HOUSE BILL 1766

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1289.21, which relates to possession or use of restricted bullets; modifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1289.21, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1289.21

POSSESSION OR USE OF RESTRICTED BULLETS

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to possess, carry upon ~~his~~ the person, use or attempt to use against another person any restricted bullet as defined in Section 1289.19 of this title.

B. Any person convicted of violating subsection A of this section shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment in the ~~State Penitentiary~~ custody of the Department of Corrections for not less than two (2) years nor more than ten (10) years. The sentence so imposed shall not be suspended.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
