HOUSE BILL 1948

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prisons and reformatories; requiring physical examination and health assessment of inmate prior to release; providing for rule promulgation; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 513.3 of Title 57, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Prior to the discharge of an inmate from the Department of Corrections, the Department of Corrections shall administer a physical examination and health assessment of the inmate. The physical examination and health assessment shall be administered no more than thirty (30) days prior to the release of the inmate from the correctional facility.

B. The Department of Corrections shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
