HOUSE BILL 2106

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public libraries; directing the Oklahoma Department of Libraries to develop and implement an Oklahoma Universal Library Card system; stating purpose of the system; authorizing the Department to enter into agreements; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-107.2 of Title 65, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

On or before July 1, 2007, the Oklahoma Department of Libraries shall develop and implement an Oklahoma Universal Library Card system. The Oklahoma Universal Library Card system will enable holders of a card to have access to the computers and computer services offered by any public library, library system, or special library in the state. The Department shall enter into agreements with public libraries, library systems, and special libraries as is necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
