HOUSE BILL 2418

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; directing school districts to increase support employee salaries; making salary increase contingent upon funding; providing conditions of payment; clarifying eligibility of support employees; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Upon the effective date of this act, the salary level of state-paid support employees, as defined in Section 6-101.40 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, employed by a local public school district shall be increased by at least five percent (5%). The salary increase provided for in this section shall be contingent upon the appropriation of state funding for such purpose. The salary increase shall be in addition to, and not as a replacement for, any portion of any salary which would have been received by a support employee in the absence of this legislation and shall be in addition to any negotiated salary increase to which a school district and support employees of that school district have previously agreed. The salary increase shall be provided to all support employees regardless of the number of hours per day the employee works.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
