HOUSE BILL 2455

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 2001, Section 3-106.1, which relates to relief from benefit wages charged; updating language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2001, Section 3-106.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3-106.1

RELIEF FROM BENEFIT WAGES CHARGED - ADDENDUM.

The benefit wages charged to an employer for a given calendar year shall be the total of the benefit wages stated in the notices given to the employer by the Commission. Provided, that on and after April 19, 1995, ~~an employer's~~ the benefit wages of an employer shall not include wages paid by the employer to any employee who was separated from his or her employment as a direct result of a natural disaster, fire, flood, or explosion that causes employees to be separated from one employer's employment. The Commission shall adopt emergency rules for immediate implementation of this section and subsequently adopt permanent rules for review by the 1996 Legislature.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
