HOUSE BILL 2492

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public lands; permitting certain leases of public lands; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 271 of Title 64, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Except as otherwise provided by law, the Commissioners of the Land Office may lease, for the purpose of establishing wireless telecommunication towers and equipment, any of the school or other lands owned by the State of Oklahoma, at a fair market rate. Proceeds from the leases shall be appropriated to the political subdivision including, but not limited to, cities, counties, and school districts, that is in direct control of the land. For the purposes of this section, the Commissioners of the Land Office may approve leases negotiated by a political subdivision with a wireless telecommunications company pertaining to the land under the control of the political subdivision.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
