HOUSE BILL 2660

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to execution process; prohibiting certain entities from revoking, suspending or denying professional license for participating in execution process; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4001 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No licensing entity, board, commission, association, or agency shall file, attempt to file, initiate a proceeding, or take any action to revoke, suspend, or deny a license to any person authorized to operate as a professional in the State of Oklahoma, for the reason that the person participated in any manner in the execution process as required or authorized by law or the Director of the Department of Corrections.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
