HOUSE BILL 2675

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;
requiring the State Department of Health to develop
certain protocol for nursing homes; authorizing
promulgation of rules; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1925.4 of Title 63, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Department of Health shall develop a nursing home
protocol for secure management and care of sex offenders. This
protocol shall require nursing homes to care for and keep sex
offenders separate and apart from the general population of the
home.

B. The State Department of Health shall promulgate rules
requiring nursing homes to provide video cameras in the rooms of
residents, halls, nurse stations, entrances, and exits.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
