HOUSE BILL 2687

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; directing the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to erect informational signs for historical sites, buildings, or properties at certain locations; specifying location; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 322 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall erect informational highway signs at each location on the state highway system where the Oklahoma Historical Society has placed a historical marker, the purpose of which is to indicate the location of a historic site, building or property. To the extent feasible, the Department shall place the informational signs on the opposite side of the road or highway directly across from the historical marker.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
