HOUSE BILL 2761

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to privacy of information; stating that obtaining certain personal information to be unlawful; stating unlawful conduct; providing penalty; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1970 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to obtain the phone records of another person without the authorization of that person by:

1. Making false or fraudulent statements or misrepresentations to an employee of a telephone service provider;
2. Accessing a customer account on the Internet without the authorization of the customer; and
3. Providing false documentation to a telephone service provider knowing that the document is false.

B. Any persons violating this section shall be guilty, upon conviction, of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
