HOUSE BILL 2770

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; authorizing the issuance of an annual permit for certain motor vehicles; providing cost of permit; providing definition; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-103G of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Commissioner of Public Safety, upon application of any person engaged in the transportation of portable buildings with a width of less than ten (10) feet, a height of less than fourteen (14) feet, and a length of less than twenty-four (24) feet, shall issue an annual permit, upon the payment of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) each year, authorizing the operation by those persons of those motor vehicles upon the highways of this state, except on the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways.

B. For purposes of this section, "portable building" means the prefabricated structural and other components incorporated and delivered by the manufacturer as a complete inspected unit with a distinct serial number. The term includes a fully assembled configuration, a partially assembled configuration, or a kit or unassembled configuration, when loaded for transport.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
