6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
8 Emergency Management; making an appropriation;
9 stating purpose; providing budgetary limitations;
10 providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget
11 procedures; providing an effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
15 Department of Emergency Management from any monies not otherwise
16 appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the
17 sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary for the purchase and maintenance of aircraft
19 related to the mission of the Civil Air Patrol.

20 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including
21 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007 (hereafter FY-07) or may be
23 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 (hereafter FY-08).
24 Funds budgeted for FY-07 may be encumbered only through June 30,
25 2007, and must be expended by November 15, 2007. Any funds
26 remaining after November 15, 2007, and not budgeted for FY-08, shall
27 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
28 year. Funds budgeted for FY-08 may be encumbered only through June
29 30, 2008. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2008, shall lapse
30 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
31 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
32 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-07, and not required to pay
obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-08, after

1 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
2 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
3 from the FY-07 budget work program and after such revision has been
4 approved by the Office of State Finance.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
