HOUSE BILL 2821

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; making certain actions unlawful; providing penalty; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 149 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. It shall be unlawful for any employee of the Department of Human Services to solicit or accept any portion of an allowance or kickback in connection with an allowance from a recipient who is otherwise entitled to the allowance.

B. Any Department of Human Services employee found guilty of violating the provisions of subsection A of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
