HOUSE BILL 2834

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to agriculture; requiring certain rate of compensation for firefighters of the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 16-21 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, firefighters employed by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall be compensated for all work performed on a legal holiday at double the rate applicable to payment for work performed on a regular work day.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
