HOUSE BILL 2915

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Office of Juvenile Affairs; requiring certain study; setting date for study and issuance of report; providing for delivery of report; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

On or before December 1, 2006, the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall conduct a study pursuant to this section. The study shall focus on the cost of building four separate secure facilities to house a maximum of fifty offenders each and the cost to incrementally construct the facilities. The Office of Juvenile Affairs shall issue a report based on the findings and recommendations of the study. The report shall be delivered to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate no later than February 1, 2007.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
