HOUSE BILL 2947

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Sections 461 and 462, which relate to larceny or destruction of records; modifying penalty; and providing effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 461, is amended to read as follows:

Section 461. Any clerk, register or other officer having the custody of any record, maps or book, or of any paper or proceeding of any court of justice, filed or deposited in any public office, who is guilty of stealing, willfully destroying, mutilating, defacing, altering or falsifying or unlawfully removing or secreting such record, map, book, paper or proceeding, or who permits any other person so to do, shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary not exceeding five (5) years, ~~and in~~ or by a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) per page, or by both such fine and imprisonment. In addition thereto, such person shall forfeit office.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 462, is amended to read as follows:

Section 462. Any person not an officer such as is mentioned in Section 461 of this title, who is guilty of any of the acts specified in that section shall be guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary not exceeding five (5) years, or in a county jail not exceeding one (1) year, or by a fine not

exceeding ~~Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)~~ One Thousand Dollars
(\$1000.00) per page, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
