HOUSE BILL 2978\_\_\_\_

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society; making an appropriation; stating purpose; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) to construct a monument to honor the contributions of black aviators in Oklahoma. The monument shall be called the "Black Aviator Memorial" and constructed on the grounds of the Tulsa International Airport.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
