HOUSE BILL 3019

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating a portion of State Highway 49 as the Medicine Park Trail; directing placement of markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1687 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 49 between Interstate 44 and the Wichita Mountains Wildlife Refuge shall be designated as the Medicine Park Trail. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the portion of highway bearing that designation.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
