HOUSE BILL 3025

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tourism and recreation; amending Section 42, Chapter 363, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 2241), which relates to seasonal employees; clarifying statutory language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 42, Chapter 363, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 2241), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2241. A. For the purposes of the Oklahoma Tourism, Parks and Recreation Enhancement Act, seasonal employees shall be unclassified employees working less than one thousand two hundred (1,200) hours in any twelve-month period. This category of employee may be employed on an intermittent, provisional, temporary, seasonal, or emergency basis.

B. The Department may employ seasonal employees throughout the calendar year. Project labor employed by the Department for a period of time necessary to complete a project shall be in the unclassified service of the state as provided by the Oklahoma Personnel Act of the Oklahoma Statutes. ~~Such~~ Seasonal and Project employees shall not be entitled to paid leave, paid holidays, retirement, health, dental or life insurance, and shall be exempt from any laws, rules or practices providing for such benefits.

C. The Department, in its annual budget request, shall include a summary of the use of project labor, which shall include the

number of workers employed under the provisions of this section and the total wages paid to these employees.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
