HOUSE BILL 3076

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to definitions and general provisions; amending 25 O.S. 2001, Section 91, which relates to the state flag design; specifying certain color shades; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2001, Section 91, is amended to read as follows:

Section 91. The banner, or flag, of the design prescribed by Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 25, Third Legislature of the State of Oklahoma shall be, and it hereby is superseded and replaced by one of the following design, to-wit:

A sky blue field with a tan circular rawhide shield of an American Indian Warrior, decorated with six painted goldenrod-colored crosses on the face thereof, the lower half of the shield to be fringed with seven pendant eagle feathers and superimposed upon the face of the shield a calumet or peace pipe that has a white mouthpiece and white body, a red bowl end, and a red tassel attached around the top, crossed at right angles by an olive green olive branch, ~~as illustrated by the design accompanying this resolution,~~ and underneath ~~said~~ the shield or design in white letters shall be placed the word "Oklahoma", and the same is hereby adopted as the official flag and banner of the State of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
