HOUSE BILL 3099

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prisons and reformatories; amending 57 O.S. 2001, Section 13, which relates to escape when committed for capital offenses; updating language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2001, Section 13, is amended to read as follows:

Section 13. If any person committed to prison, for the purpose of detaining ~~him~~ the person for trial, for a capital offense, shall break prison and escape, ~~he~~ the person shall be guilty of a felony and shall be ~~imprisoned~~ punished by imprisonment in the ~~state prison~~ custody of the Department of Corrections for the term of two (2) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
