RESOLUTION 1019

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Oklahoma Historical Society to spend certain funds to complete construction of a History Center; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Section 301 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes was enacted by the 2nd Session of the 46th Oklahoma Legislature; and

WHEREAS, this section authorized the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority to issue obligations for a variety of important projects including providing funding in an amount not to exceed Thirty-two Million Dollars (\$32,000,000.00) for the construction of a History Center for the Oklahoma Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, additional funding is needed to complete the construction of such History Center; and

WHEREAS, investment earnings from proceeds of obligations issued to provide funding for the History Center are available in the Construction Fund of the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority State Facilities Revenue Bonds, Series 1999A, for such project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT in order to complete construction of the Oklahoma History Center as planned, the Oklahoma Historical Society is hereby

authorized to spend money, including investment earnings, in the Construction Fund of the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority State Facilities Revenue Bonds, Series 1999A, for said History Center project, to the extent such amount exceeds the Thirty-two Million Dollars (\$32,000,000.00) in construction costs authorized in paragraph 2 of subsection A of Section 301 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Provided, all other requirements of the Bond Resolution for this bond issue shall be followed.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority, the Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society, the General Counsel of the Department of Central Services and the Attorney General of the State of Oklahoma.
