AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to rules of the Board of Tests for Alcohol and Drug Influence; waiving the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed amendments to permanent rule OAC 40:25-1-3, which relates to alcoholic breath simulators; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to subparagraph b of paragraph 2 of subsection B of Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature may, by concurrent resolution, waive the thirty-legislative-day review period for any rule which has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2005, the Board of Tests for Alcohol and Drug Influence submitted to the Legislature for its review proposed amendments to permanent rule OAC 40:25-1-3; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments are necessary in order to repair an incorrect reference to a vital piece of equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby waives the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed amendments to permanent rule OAC 40:25-1-3.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the Governor, the State Director of Tests for Alcohol and Drug Influence, and the Editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
