AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to rules of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners; amending proposed amendment to OAC 140:10-8-1, which relates to fees; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, approve, delay, suspend, veto, or amend the implementation of any rule or proposed rule while under review by the Legislature, determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent, and disapprove any rule or any portion thereof at any time, and the Legislature may, by concurrent resolution, disapprove any rule or amendment to a rule which has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2006, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners submitted to the Legislature for its review a proposed amendment to OAC 140:10-8-1, which relates to fees; and

WHEREAS, the rules were transmitted to the Speaker of the House during the previous interim; therefore, pursuant to subsection E of Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the thirty-legislative-day review period has not yet run; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to amend subchapter 8 of the proposed amendment to OAC 140:10-8-1 (4)(I) by striking the

term "\$200.00" and adding the term "\$100.00", to read "Continuing education application fee: \$100.00."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby amends the proposed amendment to OAC 140:10-8-1.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the Governor, the Executive Director of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners, and the editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
