AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution calling for the United States Congress to initiate hearings related to the reasons for increased gasoline prices and to determine what can be done to decrease gasoline prices; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, gasoline and diesel fuel are essential to the transportation and economic needs of all Americans; and

WHEREAS, fuel prices have a direct impact on the cost of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, gasoline prices have reached a record high of over \$2.00 per gallon; and

WHEREAS, gasoline prices are continuing to rise; and

WHEREAS, the supply and demand is not the apparent cause of the increases because the American Automobile Association reports that gasoline inventories are higher than they were a year ago.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives urges the United States Congress to investigate reasons for increased gasoline prices and to determine what can be done to decrease gasoline prices.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the President of the United States, and to members of the Oklahoma Congressional delegation.
