AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution requesting the Congressional Delegation of the State of Oklahoma to work for real immigration reform; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, illegal immigration is a growing problem for Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the federal government has not done an adequate job securing our nation's borders; and

WHEREAS, the federal government mandates that Oklahoma and other states provide education benefits to illegal aliens and Medicaid benefits to the children of illegal aliens; and

WHEREAS, to provide federally mandated benefits to illegal aliens is to create an unacceptable burden on the taxpayers of Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the House of Representatives of the State of Oklahoma requests our elected Representatives and Senators in the United States Congress to support, work to pass and vote for real immigration reform which will secure our nation's borders, prevent the imposition of costs for illegal aliens on Oklahoma and other states, and avoid an amnesty for those who have violated the law.
