AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to torts; limiting liability for certain persons providing certain services; stating exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5B of Title 76, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A volunteer who is providing transportation services as an officer, director, trustee or direct service volunteer of a charitable organization shall not be liable for any act or omission resulting in death, bodily injury or property damage if the officer, director, trustee or direct service volunteer was acting in good faith and in the scope of his or her duties or functions for the charitable organization, unless the act or omission was intentional, willfully and wantonly negligent or with reckless disregard for the safety of others.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
