SENATE BILL 1005

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;  
requiring promulgation of rules for certain pilot  
program for specified recipients; further defining  
recipients of services; providing for codification;  
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-890.2a of Title 63, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board and the State Board of  
Health shall promulgate rules and standards for a pilot Medicaid  
reimbursement program for assisted living services for two hundred  
(200) low-income, elderly Medicaid recipients. Such services shall  
be provided to recipients who would otherwise be referred for  
nursing home care.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
