SENATE BILL 1014

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; creating the Commission on Patient Safety; providing for power and duty of the Commission; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2667 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created the Commission on Patient Safety. The Commission shall have the power and duty to:

1. Facilitate the conversion from paper to electronic records, allowing medical data to be shared by all health care practitioners and facilities;
2. Link medical providers through a shared information technology infrastructure based on common standards and technology;
3. Enable patients to manage their own health records electronically; and
4. Promote public health by introducing effective health monitoring systems and enhancing research capabilities.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
