SENATE BILL 1067

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to mental health; providing legislative intent; requiring the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to create a certain program; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 12-106 of Title 43A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The purpose and intent of this act is to assist in the recovery of families of suicide victims.

B. Subject to the availability of funds, the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services shall develop and implement a counseling program to be offered to family members of suicide victims.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
