SENATE BILL 1074

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating certain memorial bridge to be named after Private First Class Curtis Herman Bullard; requiring Department of Transportation to place suitable markers on bridge; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1687 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge on State Highway 270 south of Wister, Oklahoma, shall be designated the "Private First Class Curtis Herman Bullard Memorial Bridge". Private Bullard was born October 12, 1945, and was killed in action in Pleiku Province, Vietnam, on June 20, 1966. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
