AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Office of Personnel Management; making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of Personnel Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Personnel Management by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, the Office of Personnel Management shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Personnel Management by law shall be set by the Administrator. The salary of the Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007. The Office of Personnel Management for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
