AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state employees; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-1.6, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 453, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 840-1.6), which relates to the Office of Personnel Management; providing gender-neutral language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-1.6, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 453, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 840-1.6), is amended to read as follows:

Section 840-1.6 A. The internal administrative organization of the Office of Personnel Management shall be determined by the Administrator in such a manner as to promote the efficient and effective enforcement of the Oklahoma Personnel Act.

B. The Administrator may employ attorneys, accountants and other personnel as ~~he~~ the Administrator deems necessary to carry out the duties imposed upon the Office.

C. Employees of the Office shall be subject to the Merit System of Personnel Administration, unless otherwise exempted by Section 840-5.5 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2006.
