SENATE BILL 1342

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3007, which relates to procurement of products or services at fair market price by state agencies; modifying exceptions from requirements of section; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3007, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3007. A. Whenever the State of Oklahoma or any of its agencies intends to procure any product or service included in the procurement schedule, that entity shall secure the product or service from a qualified nonprofit agency providing employment to people with severe disabilities at the fair market price determined by the Committee if the product or service is available within the period required by the entity.

B. An agency of this state shall not evade the intent and meaning of this section by slight variations from standards adopted by the Department of Central Services.

C. Provided, the requirements of this section shall not apply to the procurement of janitorial services or lawn and grounds-keeping services by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation. The Bureau shall conduct background investigations and national criminal history record checks on companies and individuals with which it

contracts to provide janitorial services or lawn and grounds-keeping services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
