SENATE BILL 1350

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Public health and safety; amending Section 1, Chapter 309, O.S.L. 2003 (63 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 2815.1), which relates to the Nine-One-One Emergency Number Act; expanding entities who may use nine-one-one emergency telephone service information under certain purposes and conditions; expanding types of applicable telephone services; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 309, O.S.L. 2003 (63 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 2815.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2815.1 A. Nine-one-one emergency telephone service information may be used by a public law enforcement or public health agency in a any city ~~having a population of more than three hundred thousand (300,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census~~ or county for the purpose of placing outgoing emergency calls that notify the public of an emergency or provide to the public information relative to an emergency.

B. Any public law enforcement or public health agency in a any city ~~having a population of more than three hundred thousand (300,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census~~ or county that uses nine-one-one emergency telephone service information for the purposes set forth in subsection A of this section shall establish methods and procedures that ensure the confidentiality of the information.

C. For purposes of this section "nine-one-one emergency telephone service information" shall mean the name, address and

telephone number of a service user of a local exchange wire line
access or wireless access telephone company.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
