SENATE BILL 1408

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to eminent domain; prohibiting use of eminent domain for certain purpose and prohibiting certain transfers of property taken by eminent domain; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5.1 of Title 27, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no governmental entity shall acquire property by eminent domain for the purpose of selling, leasing, or otherwise transferring it to a third party who is a private person, partnership, corporation, business or other private entity, and the sale, lease, or transfer of such property to such private third party is expressly prohibited.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
