SENATE BILL 1507

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; directing the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission to enter into a cooperative agreement with a certain organization to promote the Oklahoma Territorial Railroad project; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1839.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In order to promote and preserve the railroad history of Oklahoma, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission is hereby directed to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Guthrie Arts and Humanities Council, a nonprofit, 501(c)(3) organization, or any successive organization, for the purpose of assisting in the development and promotion of the Oklahoma Territorial Railroad project. The Oklahoma Territorial Railroad is a project that will operate excursion, freight and specialty trains and a railroad theme park within the forty-four (44) miles of railroad track system between Guthrie, Oklahoma, and Fairmont, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
