SENATE BILL 1519

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; creating a memorial highway honoring the 95th Division (Institutional Training); providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1687 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 177 from the intersection at Interstate 40 through Shawnee to Tecumseh shall be designated the 95th Division (Institutional Training), United States Army Reserve Command Memorial Highway. The members of the 95th Division have been widely recognized for their long standing service to our country and have been titled the "Victory Team" and the "Iron Men of Metz" to honor their brave service in World War II. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing the name of this division.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
