SENATE BILL 1525

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Section 935, which relates to the Chief Medical Examiner; making language gender-neutral; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 935, is amended to read as follows:

Section 935. The Chief Medical Examiner shall be directly responsible to the Board for the performance of the duties provided for in this act and for the administration of the office of the Chief Medical Examiner. The Chief Medical Examiner may, however, delegate specific duties to competent and qualified deputies who may act for the Chief Medical Examiner within the scope of the express authority granted by ~~him~~ the Chief Medical Examiner, subject, however, to such rules as the Board may prescribe.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
