SENATE BILL 1558

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to initiative and referendum; amending 34 O.S. 2001, Section 3.1, which relates to circulation of petition; prohibiting certain persons from circulating initiative petitions; creating felony; providing for punishment; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 34 O.S. 2001, Section 3.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3.1 It shall be unlawful for any person other than a ~~qualified elector~~ registered voter of the State of Oklahoma to circulate any initiative or referendum petition to amend, add to, delete, strike or otherwise change in any way the Constitution or laws of the State of Oklahoma, or of any subdivision of the State of Oklahoma. Every person convicted of a violation of this section shall be guilty of a felony and punished by a fine of not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by imprisonment in the ~~county jail for~~ State Penitentiary not to exceed ~~one (1) year~~ two (2) years, or by both said fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
