SENATE BILL 1576

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties and county officers; amending 26 O.S. 2001, Section 2-118, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 248, O.S.L. 2005 (26 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 2-118), which relates to the County Budget Act; clarifying language; adding certain persons to the county budget board; requiring a majority vote on certain issues; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 2-118, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 248, O.S.L. 2005 (26 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 2-118),, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1403. ~~This act~~ The County Budget Act shall apply to any county in which by resolution of a majority of the county officers and the governing body elects votes to come under and comply with all ~~it's~~ the provisions and requirements of the act. Once a county has selected the County Budget Act to govern its budget procedures, the provisions of ~~this~~ the act shall take precedence over any other state laws applicable to county budgets, except as may be provided otherwise in this act and supersede any conflicting laws. Any action of ~~a~~ the county officers and the county governing body to implement, rescind or repeal the application of ~~this~~ the County Budget act Act shall be effective as of the beginning or end of a budget year pursuant to ~~this~~ the act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
